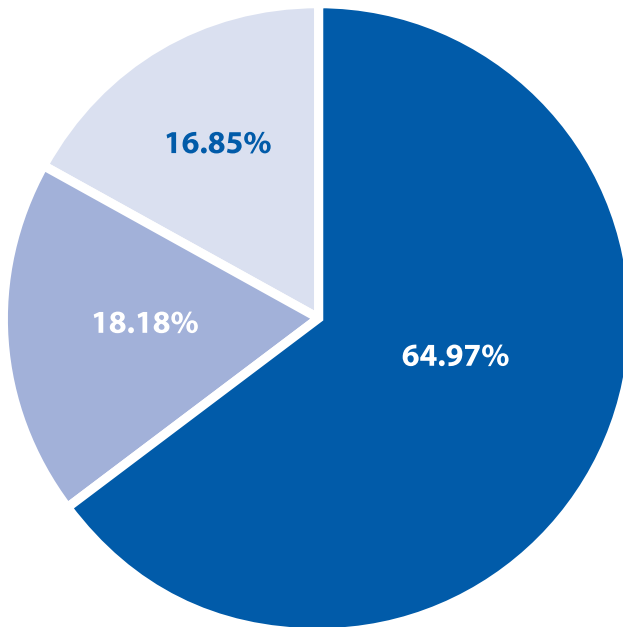


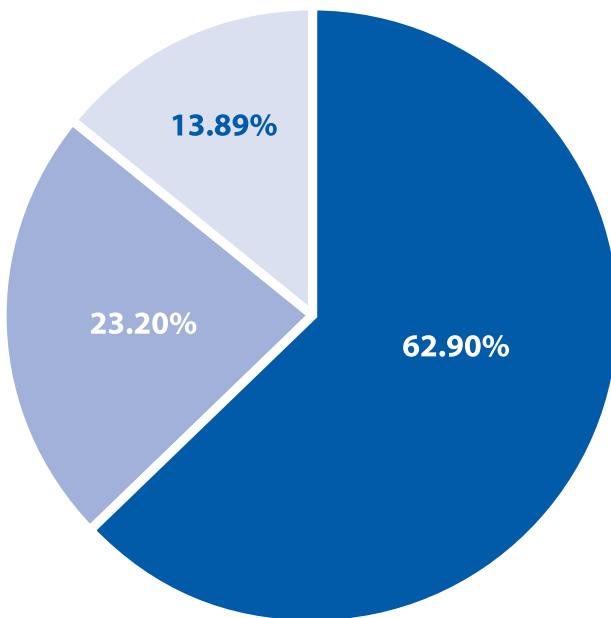


## Financial information

The total deficit for the fiscal year 2021–2022 is \$1,038,355, representing 2.29% of total expenses. This has been funded out of the surplus from the previous fiscal year (2020–2021).

## Certification Examination in Family Medicine



The fee for the Certification Examination in Family Medicine per candidate was

**\$3,270**

for the 2021–2022 fiscal period.

The candidate fee covers only the cost of the design, development, and delivery of the exam.
