## **Working group updates**

Advocacy, Community Engagement, and Ethics: As a follow-up to discussions at the Besrour Forum Deans' breakfast, the Besrour Centre endeavours to focus on two main activities under the rubric of the social accountability and dean engagement:

- Developing a strategic guide for deans to support implementing and strengthening robust family medicine training
- Organizing a platform for discussion that highlights role of the deans, with a venue for exchange between deans and community

Discussions continue to take place.

Besrour Papers and Research: The Canada-Brazil journal series is in progress, with eight papers currently in different stages of development. The group is also exploring ways to promote at the WONCA World Conference in Seoul, Korea, in October 2018.

Faculty Development: Together with the CFPC Education Department, Section of Teachers, and the Continuing Medical Education Working Group, we are developing a matrix of CFPC educational offerings. This will help the Besrour Centre's partners identify their medical education needs in their local settings. This matrix will eventually be a tangible way to better align global partners with CFPC education communities. As well, the group continues discussions with the Faculdades Santa Marcelina (FASM) in São Paulo, Brazil, working toward a curriculum redevelopment.

**Continuing Medical Education:** The group continues to seek opportunities to apply itself to a concrete CME-related initiative while exploring collaboration with other medical education forums, such as the Besrour Faculty Development Working Group and the CFPC Academic Family Medicine department.

Narratives and FM Mapping: The group's Storybooth abstract has been accepted for the WONCA World Conference in Seoul, South Korea, in October 2018. Congratulations Storybooth team!

**Resident Group:** The group has begun exploring the health impact of reconciliatory actions around the world, in collaboration with the CFPC Indigenous Health Working Group. The group is working through the PICO process in order to refine an appropriate research question to begin their literature review.

## **Kuwait Institute for Medical Specialization (KIMS)**

The CFPC was invited to Kuwait to discuss the possibility of collaboration in quality improvement for their family medicine residency program. The Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada organized the meeting, and facilitated attendance by Dr. Francine Lemire, CFPC CEO and Executive Director, and Dr. Ric Almond, CFPC Director of Accreditation. Feedback and an assessment of the KIMS family medicine program is currently under way. The Besrour Centre and CFPC are looking forward to continued collaboration and next steps with the family medicine community in Kuwait!

## **Ariadne Labs update**

Following WONCA's successful bid to Ariadne Labs (see <u>February's communication</u> for details), the Besrour Centre is pleased to be able to collaborate with colleagues at WONCA on their submission for research gaps in the organization and financing of primary health care in low- and middle-income countries.
