## CERTIFICATION FRAMEWORK

Under Mainpro+, programs will be referred to as “certified” instead of “accredited.”

Other changes include:

- New certification platform
- Mainpro+ Quality Criteria Framework, which includes six required quality measures for Mainpro+ certified programs
- Programs certified as one, two, or three credits per hour

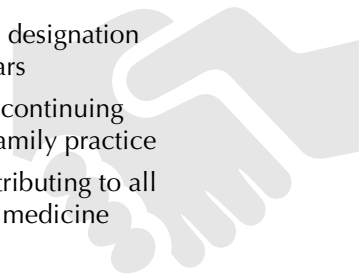
## FELLOWSHIP NOMINATION

The Fellowship designation (FCFP) will continue to be offered through a nomination process to members who distinguish themselves by making outstanding contributions to their communities, their colleagues, and the discipline of family medicine.

Fellowship is considered a value of membership and will be bestowed for life as long as the member remains in good standing with the College.

Fellowship criteria include:

- Being an active CFPC member in good standing
- Having the CCFP designation for at least 10 years
- Demonstrating a continuing commitment to family practice
- Significantly contributing to all aspects of family medicine

# Mainpro+ CHANGES

Mainpro+ will keep the best of the current system and provide new features for an improved member experience.


## What's new:

- Intuitive, easy-to-understand credit reporting categories and activity listings
- New cycle start and end dates: July 1<sup>st</sup> to June 30<sup>th</sup>
- Activity maximums are eliminated

## What stays:

- Mandatory online credit reporting
- Five-year cycle with a minimum of 250 total credits, at least 125 of which must be certified
- Minimum 25 credits earned and reported per year


## NEW ACTIVITY CATEGORIES



**GROUP LEARNING**  
Activities that provide opportunities to learn with others.



**SELF-LEARNING**  
Activities planned and implemented by the individual, outside the context of a group.



**ASSESSMENT**  
Activities that stimulate learning through analysis of data and provision of feedback about an individual or group (eg, practice audit). Assessment of learning materials may also qualify under this category.



## NEW CREDIT CATEGORIES

### + CERTIFIED CPD

Activities that have been reviewed and approved by the College as meeting standards for certified CPD

### + NON-CERTIFIED CPD

Activities that have not been formally reviewed by the College but that comply with the College's definition of CPD, are non-promotional in nature, and provide valuable professional learning opportunities

## NEW CYCLE DATES AND CREDIT CARRY-OVER CHANGES

In the new Mainpro+ system, each cycle will start on July 1<sup>st</sup> and end on June 30<sup>th</sup>. Upon successful completion of a 5-year cycle, up to 40 certified credits can be carried over to the next cycle. Carry-over credits are applicable only if extra credits are reported beyond the required 125 certified credits from the last completed cycle.

During the transition, the CFPC Mainpro+ support team will transfer all credits from Mainpro to the new Mainpro+ system.

Once the transfer is complete, members will have access to a summary of the credits they earned before the Mainpro+ changes, via their online account.

## NEW LINKING LEARNING EXERCISES

With our expanded Linking Learning program, Mainpro+ participants can now earn certified credits by completing reflection activities such as Linking Learning to teaching, assessment, research, and administration.
