Advisory Group

If you are interested in further participation on the program committee(s), the CFPC CPFM programs have established advisory groups. These committees would like your help in representing you, our members. By becoming a part of a group that advises and supports these program committees, your opinion will help guide us as we create policies, provide practice support, and work on your behalf.

We are developing a list of interested individuals from each CPFM to call on, through a listserv or other dedicated platform, when the committee needs help. These advisory groups may be used to seek your opinion on a policy statement, to work on short projects, to sit on a working group, or to help with CPD, to suggest just a few examples. Opportunities to participate will vary based on committee need.

Your participation in the CPFM program committee advisory group is voluntary. If you decide to participate in an advisory group you may opt to participate in a particular activity when asked or you may choose not to. The expected time commitment will be communicated for each activity when calling for participants; however, the groups themselves will not involve any required time from participants. We intend to update the panel on a biannual basis but you may choose to withdraw at any time. Members of the advisory group will not be financially compensated in any way.
