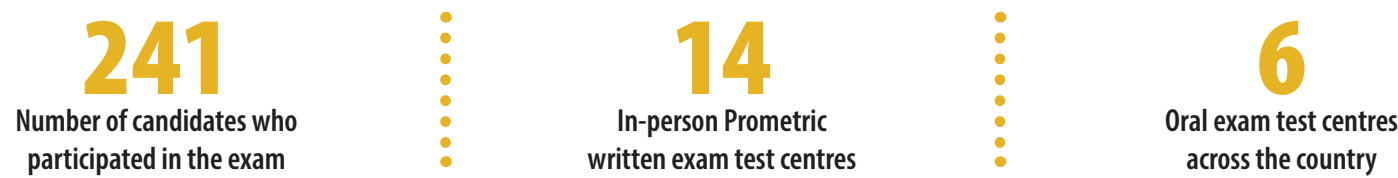




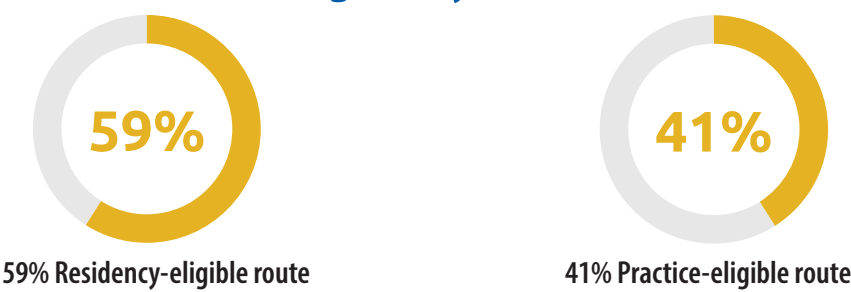
Certification of Added Competence in Emergency Medicine

2022 Examination Administration Report

The College of Family Physicians of Canada (CFPC) conducts the Examination of Added Competence in Emergency Medicine (EM) in English and French once a year at multiple centres across Canada. The 2022 exam included two components: the written component, short-answer management problems (SAMPs) held September 8th and 9th, and the structured oral on September 10th to 11th using a modified virtual delivery model. Candidates had to pass both components to be successful in this examination

The structured oral component of the examination was delivered in partnership with the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada, using a hybrid virtual model.



Candidates travelled to hotels in major Canadian cities to participate in the exam virtually from their hotel rooms.



securityPratique, an online platform, was used to deliver the oral component of the examination. Candidates were assessed by four different examiners on four different topics.
