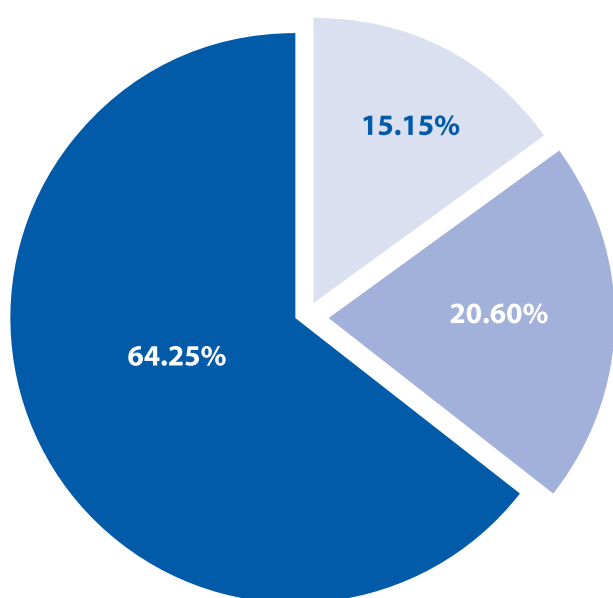
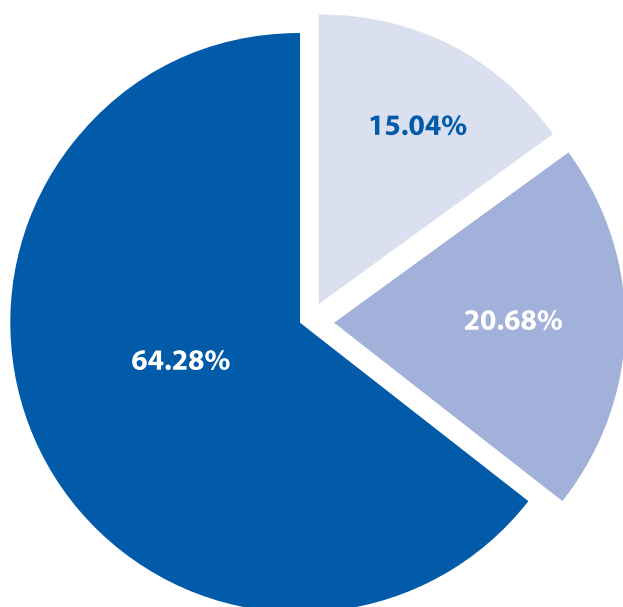

The total surplus for the year 2020–2021 is \$8,205,094, representing 20.2% of total expenses. These surplus funds are being invested in member-facing projects and programs in 2021–2022.

Certification Examination in Family Medicine



The fee for the Certification Examination in Family Medicine per candidate was

\$1,635

for the 2020–2021 fiscal period.

The candidate fee covers only the cost of the design, development, and delivery of the exam.

The Certification Examination in Family Medicine costs the CFPC

\$1,804

per candidate.

Note: There was no simulated office oral component to the Certification Examination in Family Medicine, and both the fall 2020 and spring 2021 exams were held virtually due to the pandemic.
