

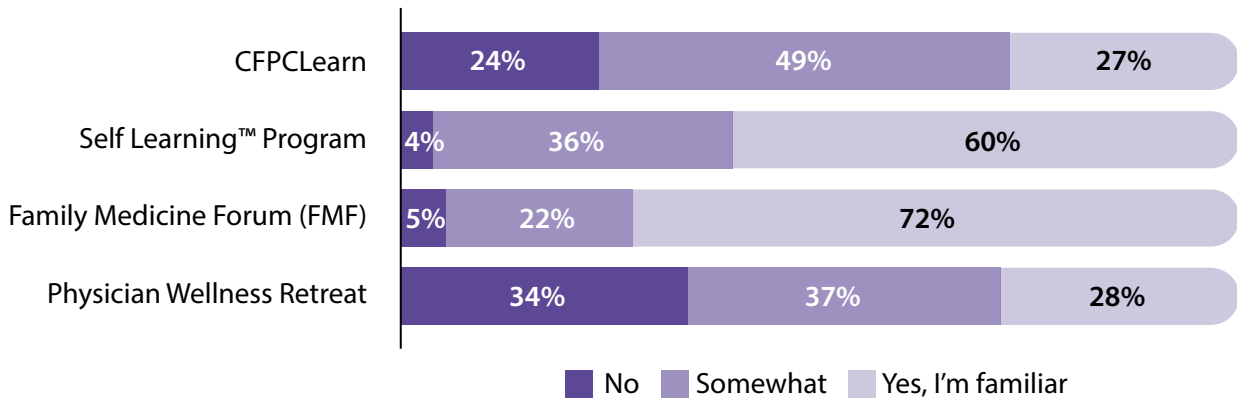


# Family doctor perspective on the CFPC's Certified Professional Development (CPD) programs

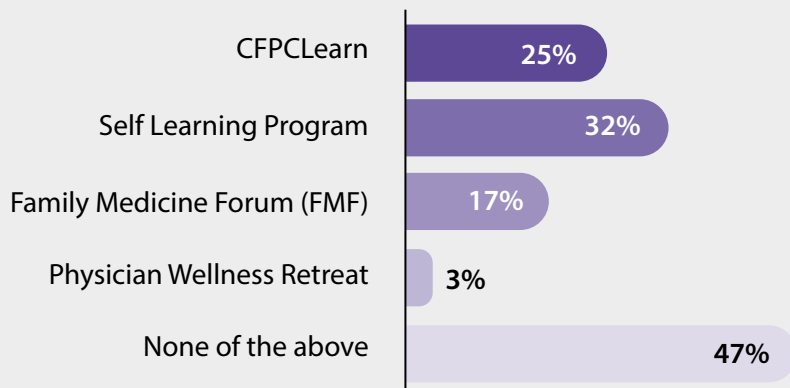

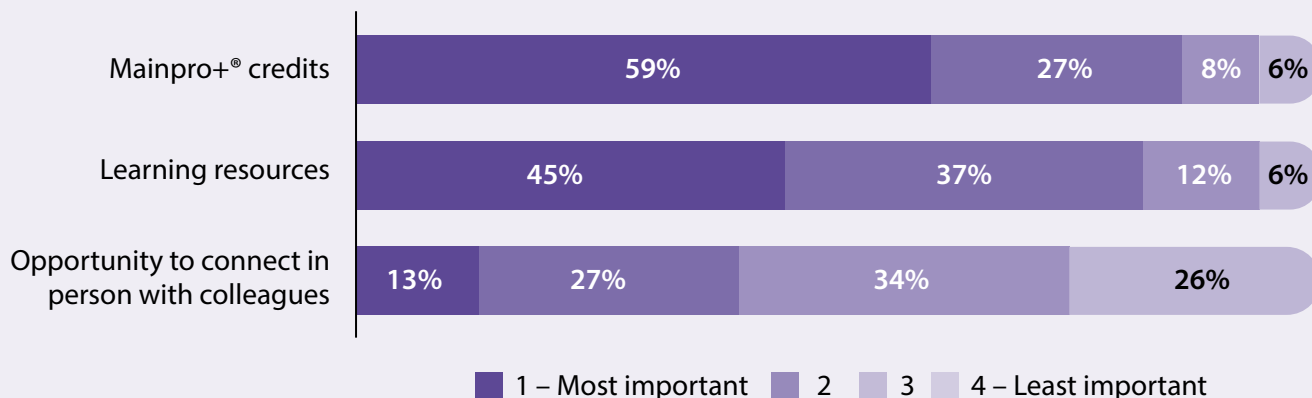
## How familiar are you with the following professional development offerings?



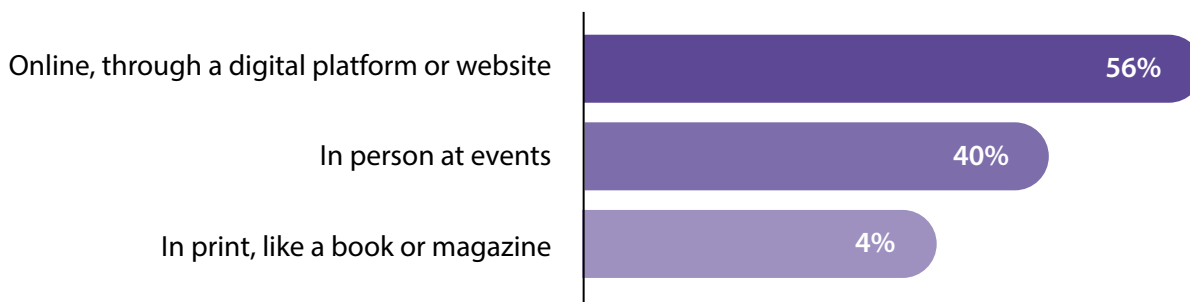
**In the past 12 months, which professional development programs/events do you currently use/attend to earn your CPD credits? (select all that apply)**



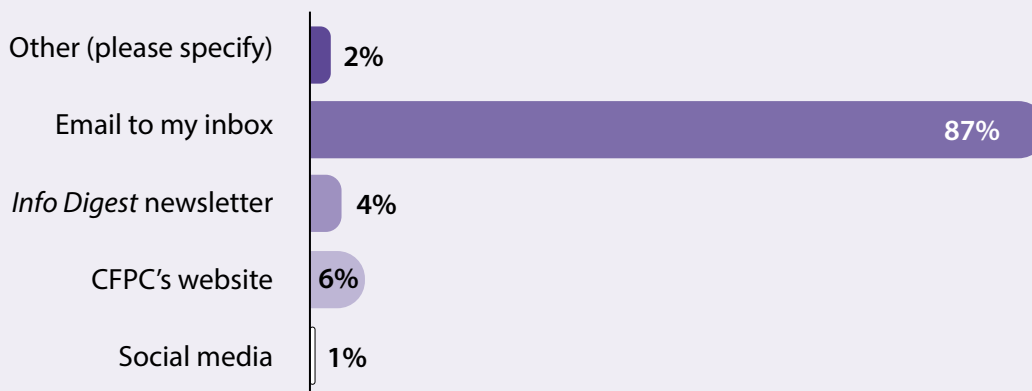
## What matters most to you when using the CFPC's professional development programs (1 being the most important to you and 4 being the least important to you)?



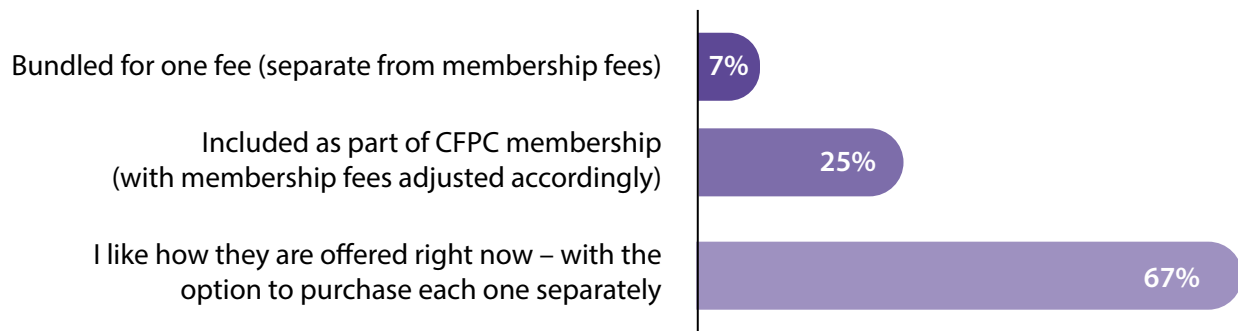
## How do you prefer to earn your CPD credits?



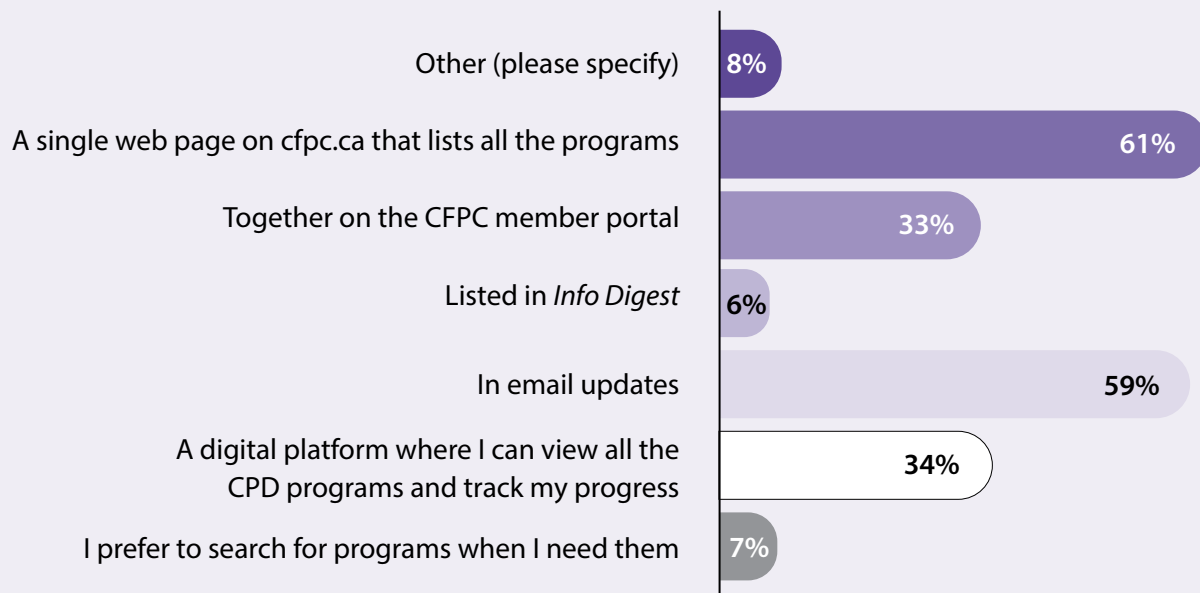
## Where do you prefer to get updates and information about CFPC professional development programs?
