





Family Doctor Perspectives on Advocacy Priorities


How well do you think the federal government reflects the value of family medicine in current health policy?




How well do you think members of the public/patients understand the value of family medicine in Canada's health care?




Pick the top three areas of advocacy that you would like the CFPC to pursue on your behalf.




What changes do you think addressing these priorities will result in for family medicine?
