The Section of Researchers' Blueprint 3 (2024–2029) is a strategic plan designed to advance family medicine research across Canada. With a focus on Capacity Building and Advocacy, the Blueprint outlines key priorities and actions necessary to strengthen the field and drive meaningful progress. It builds on previous efforts to enhance the integration of family medicine research into healthcare practices and policies.

The SOR's goal for **capacity building** is to further grow a cadre of people with the knowledge, skills, and supportive infrastructures to enable them to fully engage in family medicine research and other scholarly activities.

The SOR's **advocacy** goals aim to enhance the impact of family medicine research and scholarly activity. This includes increasing funding and non-financial support for family medicine research grants, training, infrastructure, and patient-/community-oriented family medicine scholarship. SOR advocacy aims to amplify the impact of family medicine research on practice, policy, and teaching.

The Blueprint 3 is designed to empower family medicine researchers, increase funding and other supports, and reinforce the discipline's role in improving health systems and patient care across Canada.


