Besrour Centre consultation with the Argentina Ministry of Health

The World Bank facilitated a request to the Besrour Centre to provide the Argentina Ministry of Health with consultations on various aspects of family medicine education and training in Argentina. Following months of discussion and preparation with Argentinian partners, Dr. Nancy Fowler, Executive Director, Academic Family Medicine, CFPC, Dr. Louise Nasmith, Past-President, CFPC, and Ophelia Michaelides, Manager Besrour Centre, were on site in Buenos Aires from March 18 to 22, 2019.



The CFPC team provided technical assistance to Argentinian partners for the design of a comprehensive educational proposal in family medicine along the education continuum and supported the Argentinian team in the review of their competency framework for family medicine residency and its implementation.

The Besrour Centre is honoured to have taken part in the Primary Health Care Reform process in Argentina, the vision of which is to build a health system centred around robust family medicine. The Besrour community is looking forward to further engagement with its Argentinian partners.
